


#### **Gymnastics**

This term we are going to attend gymnastics classes, at St John's Gymnastics, on Burnside Avenue, in Hawera.

Children won't need to change out of uniform, but it is helpful if they have pants or shorts that they can move in easily. They won't be able to do some of the exercises in skirts or tight pants that have little or no stretch. If you child doesn't have pants/shorts like this in navy, on Mondays we are happy for them to wear other colours to ensure safety and movement.


