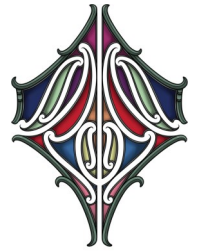

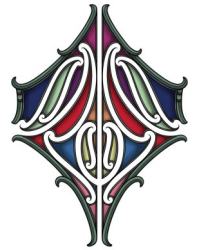

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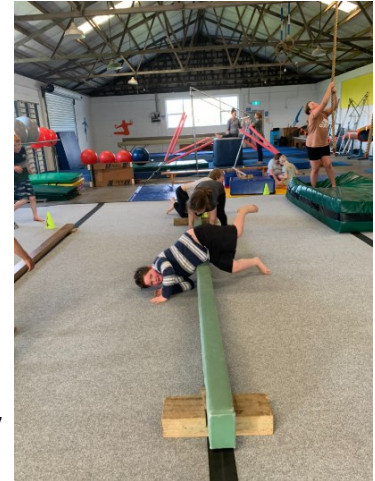
Gymnastics

This term we are going to attend gymnastics classes, at St John's Gymnastics, on Burnside Avenue, in Hawera.

We will leave school at 1:15pm on Monday afternoons, and arrive back at approximately 2:45pm. If you live or work in town, and want to pick up from the gymnastics hall, please be there by 2:25pm. You will need to let the class teacher know that you are taking your children so that we can ensure that we have the correct numbers going back to school.

For safety, the gym requires children with long hair to tie it back. From my own experience if hair is prone to get in your child's face, but not long enough to tie back, you might want to consider giving them a couple of clips to help them hold it out of their eyes for the lesson.

Children won't need to change out of uniform, but it is helpful if they have pants or shorts that they can move in easily. They won't be able to do some of the exercises in skirts or tight pants that have little or no stretch. If your child doesn't have pants/shorts like this in navy, on Mondays we are happy for them to wear other colours to ensure safety and movement.

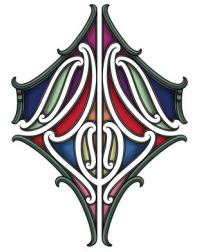
